<p><b><u>An Introduction to Restorative Practices &amp; Strategies to Implement in the Virtual Classroom</u></b></p> <p>This training is designed for staff and administrators. <p><b><u>Restorative Practices Administrator’s Training</u></b></p> <p>For administrators, classified and certified staff</p> <p>The training provides an overview of Restorative Practices as a practice that can achieve positive behavioral outcomes and improve attendance.</p> <p><b>Objective:</b> By the end of this training, participants will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Gain an overview of restorative practices in relation to discipline, school climate, and its roots in restorative justice</li> <li>• Know how and when to implement RP strategies such as affective statements, impromptu dialogue, and the use of circles in creating and sustaining an inclusive and restorative culture on campus</li> <li>• Know the Five Administrative Strategies for effectively establishing school-wide Restorative Practices and explore best practices and lessons from the field</li> </ul> <p>For up to 30 adults. <b>This training is delivered online.</b></p>	<p>4 consecutive 2-hour modules (8 hours total) \$3,000</p>
<p><b><u>Schools &amp; Families in Partnership: Restorative Practices for Distance Learning</u></b></p> <p>This 2-part series will provide parents and caregivers skills, tools and strategies they can implement in partnership with schools to bring restorative practices (RP) to life at home in order to create optimal distance learning environments for their children. Community Building, Responsive, Curriculum and Restorative Circles will be covered as participants join in and design Circles they can immediately implement with their students. <p><b><u>Restorative Practices – Conferencing</u></b></p> <p>CM partners with the International Institute of Restorative Practices (IIRP) to provide this Formal Restorative Conferencing Training.</p> <p>This 2-day training is designed for individuals experienced in Restorative Practices who are interested in facilitating restorative conferences. Participants will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn how to plan and coordinate pre-conference activities, which are essential to the success of Restorative Conferences</li> <li>• Gain skills needed for effectively facilitating conferences</li> <li>• Understand how to develop and monitor high quality follow-up plans</li> <li>• Recognize the benefits of Restorative Conferencing and their positive impacts on school discipline, suspensions and overall climate</li> <li>• Receive a copy of the International Institute for Restorative Practices (IIRP) conferencing book</li> </ul> <p>* Pre-requisite: Participants must have prior experience with RP, either completing Community Matters’ Restorative Practices Skills Development 2-day training or related experience.</p> <p>For up to 30 adults. <b>*This training can be delivered online per request.</b></p>	<p>Two-day: \$6,500</p> <p>Includes IIRP Materials</p>
